Homeowners over the age of 60 in receipt of means tested benefits such as Guaranteed Pension Credit or Council Tax Support. Last year we assisted 68 households with gas servicing and essential repairs to help them stay gas safe in their homes. The Home Solutions Team can arrange for a local Gas Safe Contractor to carry out work at the homes of successful applicants. The type of work funded by Gas Safe are gas safety checks, gas servicing, gas boiler repairs or work on gas cookers, fire, pipework or water heaters.
